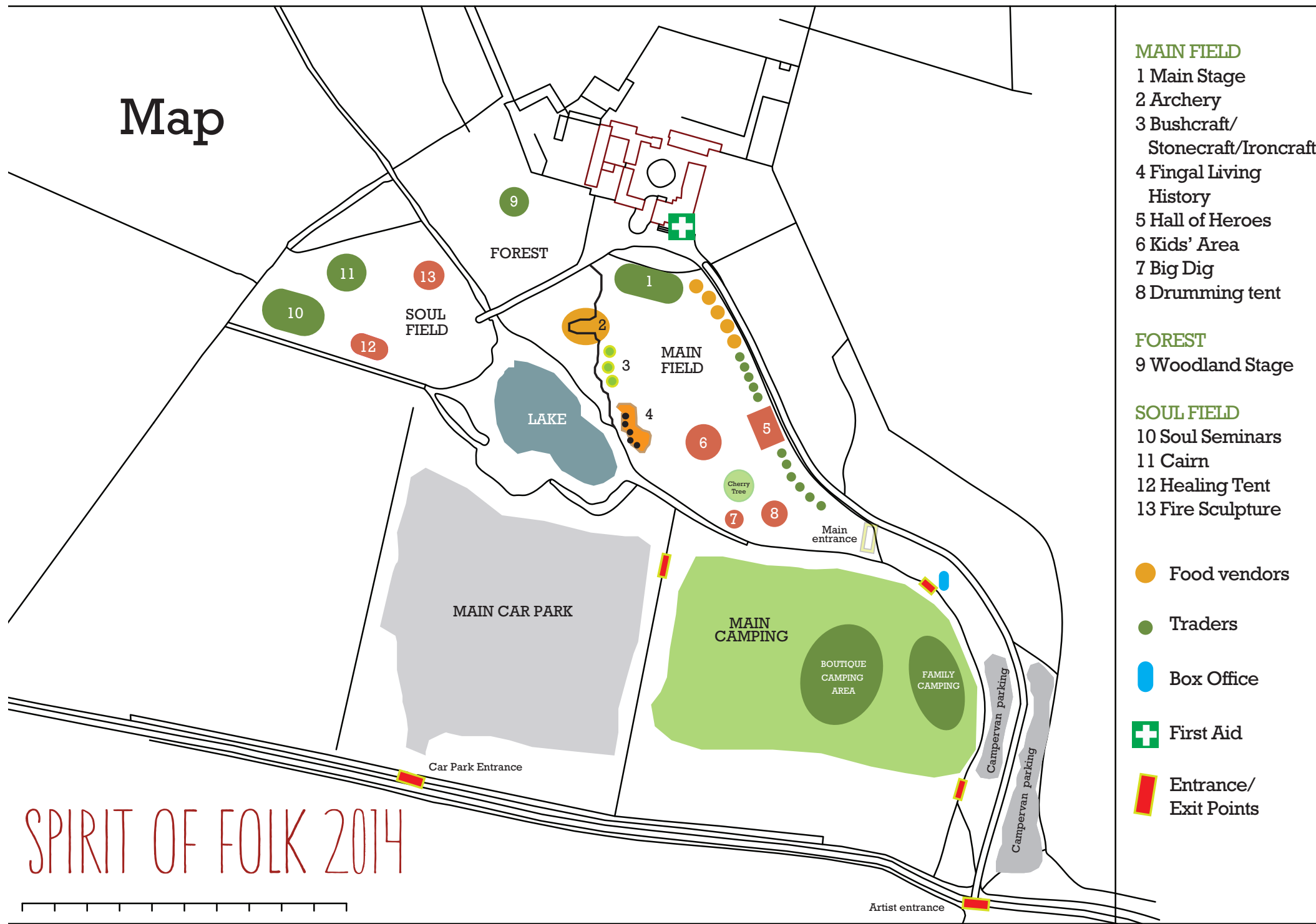

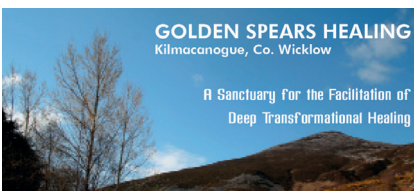
Thank you for coming to the fourth year of the Spirit of Folk festival!
